Once you have passed the UPPSC Civil Judge preliminary examination, you must prepare for the major examinations. The UPPSC Civil Judge Mains Syllabus includes the most significant topics. The UPPSC Civil Judge Exam Mains Paper consists of five sections: three

on law, one on general knowledge, and one on language. Each question in the exam is descriptive and worth 200 points. You will have three hours to complete each paper.
