Field	Description
Life Sciences	The study of living organisms and life processes. It includes areas such as biology, botany, zoology, microbiology, genetics, and ecology. It focuses on the structure, function, growth, origin, evolution, and distribution of living organisms.
Chemistry	The science that deals with the properties, composition, and structure of substances and the changes they undergo during chemical reactions. Chemistry covers topics such as organic and inorganic chemistry, physical chemistry, analytical chemistry, and biochemistry.
Physics	The science of matter, energy, and the interactions between them. Physics explores concepts like force, motion, energy, waves, electricity, magnetism, and the fundamental particles of the universe. It includes branches such as classical mechanics, quantum mechanics, thermodynamics, and electromagnetism.
